

KENYA TEA INDUSTRY PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS FOR MAY 2023 PRODUCTION

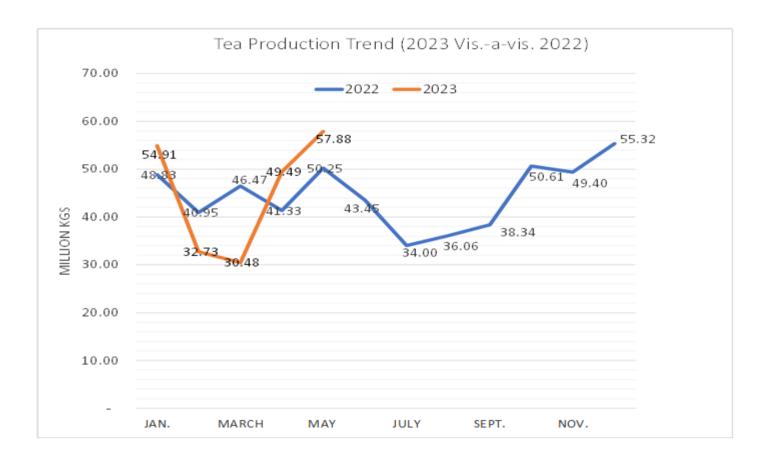
Tea production for the month of May 2023 was significantly enhanced by 7.63 Million Kgs to 57.88 Million Kgs from 50.25 Million Kgs recorded during the same period of last year. It was also higher compared to an output of 49.49 Million Kgs recorded in the month of April. Though the month of May marks the cessation of the "Long-Rains" over most parts of the country, rainfall recorded across the country was moderate and well distributed. In tea growing areas in the West of Rift, Kericho received near-normal rainfall of about 82% of its Long-term Mean precipitation for the month while the rest of the region (Bomet, Kisii/Nyamira and Nandi) recorded moderate rainfall. In the East of Rift, high rainfall ranging an average of 98-178mm daily was recorded in the first week of May and moderate rainfall during the rest of the month. As a result, output in the West of Rift was higher by 5.22 Million Kgs from 32.81 Million Kgs recorded during the same month of 2022 to 38.03 Million Kgs. Similarly, production within the East of Rift was enhanced by 2.42 Million Kgs from 17.43 Million Kgs to 19.85 Million Kgs.

Across the sub-sectors, production within the plantation sub-sector was higher by 6.30 Million Kgs from 22.45 Million Kgs to 28.75 Million Kgs on account of good rainfall in Kericho and moderate precipitation across the other areas in the West of Rift Region where the sub-sector has a wider coverage. Output in the smallholder sub-sector was higher by 1.33 Million Kgs from 27.79 Million Kgs recorded during the corresponding month of

2022 to 29.12 Million Kgs owing to moderate and well distributed rainfall in the East of Rift.

Despite good production in the month of May, tea output for the first five months of 2023 was lower by 2.34 Million Kgs to stand at 225.51 Million Kgs against 227.85 Million Kgs for the same period of last year. Lower output was due to severe hot and dry weather conditions experienced in the months of February and March.

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TEA SALES

AUCTION

During the month of May, auction sales volume for Kenya tea stood at 36.75 Million Kgs, which was lower compared to 38.85 Kgs Million recorded in the corresponding month of last year but higher than 26.93 Million Kgs recorded in April. The average monthly auction price for Kenya tea was also lower at 2.19 USD per Kg against 2.40 USD for the same period of 2022 and 2.39 recorded in April. However, tea offered for sale by the smallholder tea factories fetched a higher price at an average of 2.62 USD per Kg for the main grades.

Lower auction sales volume and price was occasioned by continued effect of economic recession facing the global markets especially Pakistan, Egypt, Sudan, Russia and Iran, which are some of the main markets for Kenya tea. This impact has been experienced since the commencement of Russia-Ukraine crisis in February 2022 and the armed conflict in Sudan in April 2023. During the month, exporters to Sudan and Iran did not participate in tea buying at the auction.

EXPORTS

The total export volume for the month of May was lower by 3% (1.15 Million Kgs) from 36.56 Million Kgs recorded in the same period of last year to 35.41 Million Kgs. However, the exports for the month was much higher compared to 24 Million Kgs recorded in April and 31.66 Million Kgs recorded in March 2023 owing to improved imports by Pakistan, U.A.E and Yemen. During the month, Pakistan maintained its position as the leading export destination for Kenya tea having imported 15.16 Million Kgs, which was an increase compared to 8.03 Million Kgs in April and March, respectively. This follows Government intervention to prioritize forex allocation Pakistan for importation of tea as an essential food item. During the month on May, Kenya tea was shipped to forty-seven (47) export destinations compared to forty (40) for the same period of last year with Pakistan accounting for 43% TEA INDUSTRY PERFORMANCE REPORT MAY 2023

of the total export volume. Other key export destinations for Kenya tea were UAE (3.64 Million Kgs); UK (3.56 Million Kgs); Yemen (2.43 Million Kgs); Egypt (2.34 Million Kgs); Russia (1.23 Million Kgs); Poland (0.76 Million Kgs); Ireland (0.74 Million Kgs); Afghanistan (0.57 Million Kgs) and Saudi Arabia (0.53 Million Kgs); The top ten export destinations, majority of which are traditional markets for Kenyan tea accounted for 87% of Kenya tea export volume. Apart from Pakistan; UAE; and Yemen, there were increased exports to other traditional markets such as UK; Saudi Arabia and Ireland compared to the same period of last year. However, Egypt; Russia; Poland; and Afghanistan recorded less imports for Kenya tea due to continued challenge of forex reserves and inflationary pressure attributed to the effect of the ongoing Russia-Ukraine crisis. Sudan, which is a traditional market for Kenya tea imported significantly less quantity at 0.104 Million Kgs compared to 1.565 Million Kgs for the same period of last year due to market access challenges occasioned by the ongoing armed conflict in the country. Other markets that recorded lower imports include Kazakhstan; South Africa; Ukraine; and Iran. However, there were improved exports to other nontraditional and emerging markets such as Jordan; Malaysia; Nigeria; Netherlands and Somalia as well as fewer shipments to seasonal markets such as Cameroon; Romania; Chad; Iraq; Israel; Burkina Faso; Taiwan; Senegal; Italy; and Myanmar.

LOCAL TEA SALES

Local tea sales for May 2023 stood at 3.08 Million Kgs against 2.41Million Kgs for the corresponding period of 2022 while cumulative tea sales for the five months period up to May 2023 stood at 14.55 Million Kgs, which was higher against 12.45 Million Kgs for the same period of 2022 but lower compared to 15.44 Million Kgs for the same period of 2021.
