KENYA TEA INDUSTRY PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS FOR JULY 2022 PRODUCTION

Tea production for the month of July 2022 recorded a significant drop from 43.27 Million Kgs in June and 50 Million Kgs in May to 33.85 Million Kgs. Though this was the lowest monthly production for the year-to-date, it was within the seasonal average output usually recorded in the month of July. Drop in production for the month of July follows minimal rainfall and occasional rain experienced in most parts of the country as well as cold and cloudy conditions. During the month, weather conditions in the highlands East of the Rift Valley was characterized by occasional drizzle or light rains coupled with cool temperatures. In the West of the Rift Valley, certain tea growing areas especially in Kericho and Nandi recorded modest precipitation while the rest such as Bomet, Nyamira and Kisii experienced dry weather conditions or lower rainfall of less than 10 mm daily.

Consequently, in tea growing areas in the West of Rift Valley, production dropped by about 0.48 Million Kgs from 28.40 Million Kgs recorded during the corresponding month of 2021 to 27.91 Million Kgs. Production in the region was also lower compared to 31.87 Million Kgs recorded during the month of June.

Similarly, within the East of the Rift, production was lower by about 0.39 Million Kgs from 5.93 Million Kgs recorded during the corresponding month of 2021 to 6.32 Million Kgs. Production in the region was also significantly lower compared to 11.39 Million Kgs Million Kgs recorded during the month of June.

Due to unfavourable weather conditions in the West of Rift Valley (Bomet, Nyamira and Kisii) and lower rainfall in the East of Rift Valley, production in the smallholder subsector dropped by about 2.28 Million Kgs from 15.00 Million Kgs recorded during the

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corresponding month of 2021 to 12.72 Million Kgs. However, production within the Plantation sub-sector was higher by about 1.40 Million Kgs from 19.73 Million Kgs recorded during the corresponding month of 2021 to 21.13 Million Kgs due to moderate rainfall received in certain tea growing areas of the West of Rift Valley where the sub-sector is more prevalent.

Cumulative production for the seven-month period was lower by 4.59 Million Kgs to stand at 304.22 Million Kgs against 308.81 Million Kgs recorded during the corresponding period of 2021. Going by the trend to-date, lower cumulative production is likely to continue throughout the rest of the year.

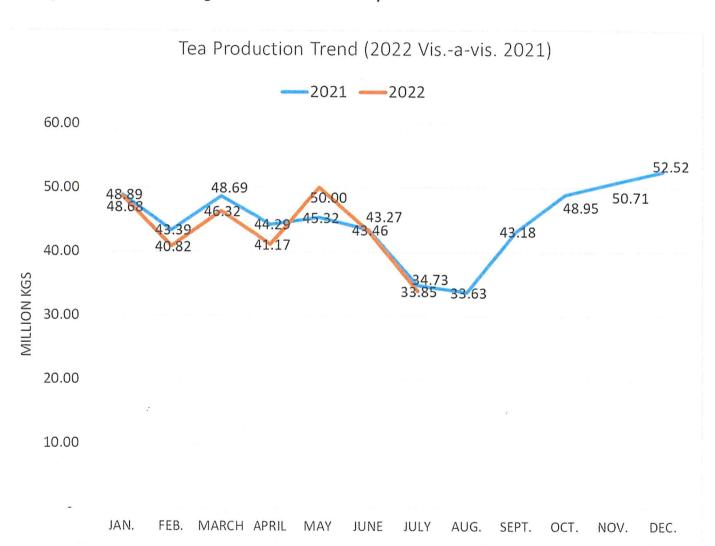

TEA SALES

<u>AUCTION</u>

During the month of July, auction sales volume for Kenyan tea stood at 28.15 Million Kgs, which was lower compared to 38.35 Million Kgs recorded in the corresponding month of last year. It was also lower in comparison with 40.54 Million Kgs sold in the month of June. Lower teas on offer for sale at the auction follows reduced supply on account of declining production trend.

The average auction price for Kenyan tea during the month of July this year was slightly lower at 2.37 USD per Kg compared to 2.44 USD per Kg recorded in June and 2.41 USD per Kg in May. However, it was higher compared to 1.75 USD and 1.81 USD recorded during the same period of 2021 and 2020, respectively. For all the teas offered for sale at the auction during the month, "Best" category across CTC leaf and dust grades fetched higher prices especially those that were well sorted grades and had brighter liquors. Notably, there was no Orthodox tea grades on offer at the auction during the month.

During the seven-month period of the year, average auction prices for Kenya tea stood at USD 2.53 per Kg, which was significantly higher compared to USD 1.93 for the same period of 2021, USD 2.02 in 2020 and USD 2.19 in 2019. During the seven-month period of 2022, tea offered for sale by the smallholder tea factories fetched an average price of USD 2.73 per Kg for the main grades from an average price of USD 2.17 for January - July 2021 and USD 2.20 for the same period of 2020.

Though the auction prices have been on an upward trajectory after experiencing a declining trend to a low of 1.75 USD per Kg in July 2021, the auction prices during the period March-July 2022 have slackened due to the effect of global economic shock brought about by the Russia-Ukraine crisis. The crisis, which commenced towards the end of February this year has had a negative effect on the economic growth of most

markets thus causing a global recession. As a result of the crisis, most global economies are experiencing scarcity of foreign exchange reserves and depreciation of their local currencies leading to high inflation, slow economic growth and low purchasing power. During the month, buyers of tea for Russia and Iran markets were less active at the auction.

EXPORTS

The total export volume for the month of July 2022 was lower by 22% from 31.49 Million Kgs recorded in the same period of last year to 40.59 Million Kgs. It was also lower compared to export volumes recorded during the preceding months. The number of export markets were also lower at forty seven (47) compared to forty nine (49) for the same period of last year. Decline in exports was majorly due to effect of Russia-Ukraine crisis that continued to cause global economic recession and thus negatively affecting purchasing power in most markets.

Pakistan maintained its position as the leading export destination for Kenyan tea having imported 12.28 Million Kgs compared to 16.41 Million Kgs imported during the same month last year. Despite lower import volume, Pakistan accounted for 39% of the total export volume. Other key export destinations for Kenyan tea were Egypt (3.85 Million Kgs); UK (3.00 Million Kgs); UAE (2.44 Million Kgs); Sudan (1.63 Million Kgs); Yemen (1.50 million Kgs); Poland (0.740 Million Kgs); Kazakhstan (0.73 Million Kgs); Russia (0.67 Million Kgs); and Nigeria (0.65 Million Kgs). The top ten export destinations, majority of which are traditional markets for Kenyan tea accounted for 87% of Kenya tea export volume. Apart from UAE and Yemen, most of the other traditional markets recorded lower tea imports from Kenya compared to the same period of last year. Decline was also recorded in other key markets such as in Iran; Switzerland; USA; Netherlands; Ireland; India; and Oman. Notably, a few shipments were recorded in seasonal markets such as Jordan; Peru; Zambia; Chile; Cote D'ivoire; Burkina Faso; Iraq; Estonia; and Bahrain.

Cumulative export volume for January to July was lower by 19% to stand at 274.83 Million Kgs compared to 339.27 Million Kgs for the seven-month period of last year.

LOCAL TEA SALES

Local tea sales for July 2022 stood at 3.09 Million Kgs against 3.18 Million Kgs for the corresponding period of 2021 while cumulative sales in the local market for the seven months' period up to July 2022 was lower at 18.14 Million Kgs against 21.90 Million Kgs for the same period of 2021 and 24.39 Million Kgs for the seven month period of 2020. Lower sales during the year to-July was attributed to lower demand due to continued effect of inflationary pressure on basic commodity prices occasioned by global economic recession, weakening of the Kenya Shilling against the USD and increase in fuel prices. Overall inflation rate for the seven month period of 2022 was higher at an average of 6.54 percent compared to 5.98 percent for the same period of 2021 and 5.58 percent in 2020.
