# KENYA TEA INDUSTRY PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS FOR NOVEMBER 2023

#### **PRODUCTION**

Tea production for the month of November 2023 was much more enhanced by 1.68 Million Kgs from 49.22 Million Kgs registered during the same period of 2022 to 50.90 Million Kgs. Higher production was attributable to heavy downpour experienced during the first week of the month which is characteristic of November, as it usually marks the peak of "October-December" seasonal rainfall. In tea growing regions within the East of Rift (Kiambu; Muranga/Nyeri/Kirinyaga and Embu/Meru), high precipitation (above-average rainfall ranging from 159 mm to 330 mm daily) was recorded in the first week of the month. However, the rainfall gradually waned to less than 10 mm daily towards the end of the month. In the West of Rift Valley, the amounts of rainfall experienced was moderate in Kericho (21 mm to 116.4mm) but slightly lower in the rest of the region (Nandi; Nyamira/Kisii and Bomet) at 5 mm to 75.8 mm. Consequently, production within the East of Rift in the month of November was significantly higher by 2.96 Million Kgs from 13.58 Million Kgs recorded in the same period 2022 to 16.54 Million Kgs. However, owing to low precipitation, output in the West of Rift during the month of November 2023 was lower by 1.27 Million Kgs from 35.63 Million Kgs recorded during the same month of 2022 to 34.36 Million Kgs. Across the sub-sectors, Smallholder sub-sector, which is more widespread in the East of Rift, recorded higher output by 2.95 Million Kgs from 22.06 Million Kgs to 25.01 Million Kgs. Owing to wider coverage of the Plantation sub-sector in the areas that recorded lower rainfall in the West of Rift, output within the sub-sector was less by 1.27 Million Kgs from 27.15 Million Kgs to 25.88 Million Kgs.

Notably, due to continued good weather conditions during the period between April to November, cumulative output for first eleven months of the year 2023 was higher by 37.92 Million Kgs to stand at 515.92 Million Kgs against 477.99 Million Kgs for the same period of 2022.



## TEA SALES

#### **AUCTION**

During the month of November, auction sales volume for Kenya tea stood at 48.69 Million Kgs which was lower against of 58.28 Million Kgs recorded in October, but higher compared to 42.97 Million Kgs in September and 32.09 Million Kgs recorded in the corresponding month of 2022. The average auction price for Kenya tea in the month of November was lower at 2.17 USD per Kg against 2.46 USD realized during the same period of 2022 and 2.55 USD in 2021. Nevertheless, for each specific grade, the price followed demand and quality (leaf appearance and leaf infusion as well as liquoring characteristics). For smallholder tea factories, whose quality categorization ranges from "good medium" to "best", tea offered for sale fetched relatively higher prices at an average of 2.86 USD per Kg for the main grades against 2.73 USD recorded in the same period of 2022.

During the eleven-month period of 2023, the average auction price for Kenya tea stood at 2.24 USD per Kg, which was lower compared to 2.49 USD per Kg for the same period of 2022. The auction prices have experienced a prolonged depressed since the second quarter of 2022 owing to less demand occasioned by continued effect of economic recession facing the global markets. The global recession, which is largely attributed to effects of the ongoing Russia-Ukraine crisis and the recent armed conflict in Sudan has continued to affect tea imports in some of the main markets for Kenya tea especially Pakistan, Egypt, Sudan, Russia and Iran. During the month of November, participation of buyers for Sudan, Russia and Iran markets at the auction was intermittent. Following the ban imposed by Pakistan authorities on items imported into the country under Afghan Transit Trade Agreement in

October, there were lower purchases at the auction by Afghanistan buyers. However, as an emerging market, South Sudan recorded improved buying support for tea at the auction.

#### **EXPORTS**

The total export volume for the month of November 2023 was higher by 41% (16.47 Million Kgs) from 40.65 Million Kgs recorded in the same period of 2022 to 57.13 Million Kgs. Improved exports was on account of increased purchases in anticipation of higher demand in the winter season. During the month, Pakistan maintained its position as the leading export destination for Kenya tea having imported 24.45 Million Kgs, which was an increase of 38% compared to 17.67 Million Kgs imported during the corresponding period of 2022.

During the month on November, Kenya tea was shipped to fifty-nine (59) export destinations compared fifty-four (54) for the same period of 2022 with Pakistan accounting for 42.8% of the total export volume. Other key export destinations for Kenya tea were Egypt (6.62 Million Kgs); UAE (4.06 Million Kgs); UK (3.94 Million Kgs); Yemen (2.39 Million Kgs); Sudan (2.21 Million Kgs); Russia (1.65 Million Kgs); India (0.98 Million Kgs); Iran (0.96 Million Kgs); and Chad (0.95 Million Kgs). The top ten export destinations, majority of which are traditional markets for Kenya tea accounted for 84.5% of Kenya tea export volume. Compared to the same period of 2022, more exports were recorded in traditional markets with the exception of UK and Russia. UK, which used to re-export tea to the neighbouring countries has been recording lower imports since its exit from European Union. Similarly, exports to Russia have been declining due to market access challenges occasioned by the Russia-Ukraine crisis. Notably, Chad which did not import tea directly from Kenya in November 2022 was one of the top-ten export destinations in November 2023. Prior to the conflict in Sudan, Chad which is a land locked country, would get its commodity supplies including tea from

Sudan. However, due to the blockage of trade routes from Sudan, Chad has now shifted to Nigeria and Cameroon as alternative sources of commodity supplies and imports transhipment.

Similar to the traditional markets, most of the non-traditional markets recorded improved growth compared to the corresponding month of 2022. Shipments were also recorded in seasonal and emerging markets such as Uzbekistan; Bangladesh; Vietnam; Qatar; South Sudan; Australia; Spain; Central African Republic; El Salvador; Djibouti; Romania; Gabon; Angola; Hungary; and South Korea. Notably, South Sudan is the latest emerging market for Kenya tea.

Cumulatively up to November 2023, the quantity of tea exports were up by 3.6% from 405.16 Million Kgs recorded in the same period 2022 to 419.75 Million Kgs.

### **LOCAL TEA SALES**

Local tea sales for November 2023 was higher at 3.31 Million Kgs against 3.28 Million Kgs for the corresponding period of 2022 while cumulative tea sales for the first eleven months of 2023 stood at 33.84 Million Kgs, which was higher against 31.17 Million Kgs for the same period of 2022 but marginally lower compared to 34.55 Million Kgs for the same period of 2021.
