# KENYA TEA INDUSTRY PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS FOR OCTOBER 2023

#### **PRODUCTION**

Tea production for the month of October 2023 recorded improved performance by 2.18 Million Kgs from 50.61 Million Kgs registered during the same period of last year to 52.79 Million Kgs. Production for October was also much more enhanced compared to 48.30 Million Kgs recorded in September and 45.57 Million Kgs in August this year. Improved production was attributed to wet weather conditions experienced in several parts of the country during the month of October, which was a continuation from the month of September over several parts of the country. In other parts of the country, this was followed by the onset of the "short" seasonal rains which commenced from the third to fourth week of October. The month was characterized by heavy storms and warmer temperatures, which according to the weather review by Kenya Meteorological Department, was an indication of the presence of El Niño conditions that is usually associated with aboveaverage rainfall over East Africa. In tea growing regions in the West and North of Rift Valley, the rainfall was moderate but well distributed throughout the month especially in Kericho, Bomet and Nandi. However, in the East of Rift, lower rainfall was recorded in most parts of the tea growing regions with the exception of Embu/Meru and Kiambu where above-average rainfall (36 mm to 61 mm daily and 58mm to 76mm) was recorded in the second half of the month. Consequently, output in the West of Rift during the month of October this year was significantly higher by 4.77 Million Kgs from 31.26 Million Kgs recorded during the same month of 2022 to 36.03 Million Kgs. Production within the East of Rift in the month of October was lower compared to the same period last year by 2.60 Million Kgs from 19.35 Million Kgs to 16.75 Million Kgs.

Owing to wider coverage of the Plantation sub-sector in the areas that recorded favourable weather conditions in the West of Rift, output within the sub-sector was higher by 2.88 Million Kgs from 24.44 Million Kgs to 27.32 Million Kgs. Across the smallholder sub-sector, which is more widespread in the East of Rift, output was lower by 0.71 Million Kgs from 26.17 Million Kgs to 25.46 Million Kgs.

Notably, due to continued good weather conditions during the period between April and October, cumulative output for first ten months of the year 2023 was higher by 32.58 Million Kgs to stand at 412.22 Million Kgs against 379.64 Million Kgs for the same period of last year.

#### **TEA SALES**

#### **AUCTION**

During the month of October, auction sales volume for Kenya tea stood at 58.28 Million Kgs, which was higher compared to 42.97 Million Kgs in September and 38.63 Million Kgs recorded in the corresponding month of last year. However, it was lower in comparison with 61.16 Million Kgs sold in August. The average auction price for Kenya tea in the month of October was lower at 2.16 USD per Kg against 2.49 USD realized during the same period of 2022 and 2.42 USD in 2021. It was also lower in comparison with 2.25 USD per Kg realized in September. Nevertheless, for each specific grade, the price followed demand and quality (leaf appearance and leaf infusion as well as liquoring characteristics). For smallholder tea factories, whose quality categorization ranges from "good medium" to "best", tea offered for sale fetched relatively higher prices at an average of 2.78 USD per Kg for the main grades against 2.76 USD recorded in the same period of 2022.

During the ten-month period of 2023, the average auction price for Kenya tea stood at 2.24 USD per Kg, which was lower compared to 2.50 USD per Kg for the same period of 2022. The auction prices have been on a declining trend since the second quarter of 2022 owing to less demand occasioned by continued effect of economic recession facing the global markets. The global

recession, which is largely attributed to effects of the ongoing Russia-Ukraine crisis and the recent armed conflict in Sudan has continued to affect tea imports in some of the main markets for Kenya tea especially Pakistan, Egypt, Sudan, Russia and Iran. During the month of October, Sudan, Russia and Iran maintained low buying participation at the auction. Following the ban imposed by Pakistan authorities on items imported into the country under Afghan Transit Trade Agreement in October, there were lower purchases at the auction by Afghanistan buyers. However, as an emerging market, South Sudan recorded improved buying support for tea at the auction.

## **EXPORTS**

The total export volume for the month of October was higher by 44% (14.71 Million Kgs) from 33.22 Million Kgs recorded in the same period of last year to 47.96 Million Kgs. During the month, Pakistan maintained its position as the leading export destination for Kenya tea having imported 17.81 Million Kgs, which was an increase of 17% compared to 15.21 Million Kgs imported during the corresponding period of last year.

During the month on October, Kenya tea was shipped to fifty-six (56) export destinations compared fifty-five (55) for the same period of last year with Pakistan accounting for 37% of the total export volume. Other key export destinations for Kenya tea were Egypt (8.86 Million Kgs); UK (3.31 Million Kgs); UAE (2.12 Million Kgs); Yemen (1.80 Million Kgs); Russia (1.60 Million Kgs); Sudan (1.31 Million Kgs); Iran (1.16 Million Kgs); Kazakhstan (0.86 Million Kgs); and Saudi Arabia (0.77 Million Kgs). The top ten export destinations, majority of which are traditional markets for Kenya tea accounted for 83% of Kenya tea export volume.

Compared to the same period of last year, more exports were recorded in traditional markets with the exception of Russia and Sudan, which for the quite a while have been facing market access challenges occasioned by the Russia-Ukraine crisis and internal conflict in Sudan, respectively. Cumulatively up to October, the quantity of tea exports to Russia were down by 21% while in Sudan it was lower by about 49% compared to the same period last year. However, most of the traditional and emerging markets recorded improved exports on account of increased purchases in anticipation of higher demand in the winter season. Similarly, there were exports to seasonal markets such as South Sudan; Eritrea; Zambia; Israel; Spain; Senegal; Venezuela; Mali; and Gambia.

### LOCAL TEA SALES

Local tea sales for October 2023 was higher at 3.34 Million Kgs against 3.31 Million Kgs for the corresponding period of 2022 while cumulative tea sales for the first ten months of 2023 stood at 30.53 Million Kgs, which was higher against 27.89 Million Kgs for the same period of 2022 but marginally lower compared to 31.03 Million Kgs for the same period of 2021.
